

Announcement of the Graduate School, Chiang Mai University
No. 015/2012

Subject Procedures for Verifying a Student's Forfeiture Status, as when a Student Fails to Enroll within the Specific Time Frame and does not Register a Leave of Absence, within 30 days from the Commencement of a Regular Semester.

According to the Regulations of Chiang Mai University, Graduate Study 2007 and 2011 Article 27(5), a student will forfeit his/her student standing when he/she fails to enroll within the specific time frame and doesn't register a leave of absence, within 30 days from the commencement of a regular semester.

To ensure that verifying a student's forfeiture status, as when a student fails to enroll within the specific time frame and does not register a leave of absence, within 30 days from the commencement of a regular semester, is conducted smoothly and with the approval of the committee of the Graduate School, during the meeting 24/2012, held on 9th November, 2012, it was agreed to adjust the regulations on graduate study as follows:

1. The Announcement of the Graduate School, Chiang Mai University No. 0008/2008, concerning Procedures for Verifying a Student's Forfeiture Status, as when a Student Fails to Enroll within the Specific Time Frame and does not Register a Leave of Absence, within 30 days from the Commencement of a Regular Semester, signed on 12th May, 2008, is nullified and the following procedures replace it.

2. The Registration Office will bring the name list of students who fail to enroll within the specific time frame and do not register a leave of absence within 30 days from the commencement of a regular semester to the attention of the following authorities:

2.1 The Faculty will verify whether the student named has registered in time or not, and within seven days will inform the Graduate School.

2.2 The Graduate School, when having received the list of students will check for the student verification, the student's resignation, and the student's leave of absence. The Graduate School will also check with the Faculty. After that the Graduate School will inform the registration office within seven days of receiving the notification from the Faculty.

3. The Registration Office revokes the student's student status.

4. A student who has forfeited his/her student status because of his/her failure to enroll within the specific time frame or not registering a leave of absence within 30 days from the commencement of a regular semester, and wishes to regain his/her student status, must subsequently follow the specifications set out in the Chiang Mai University Graduate School Announcement on Procedures for Regaining Student Status.
