**Announcement of the Graduate School, Chiang Mai University
No. 8 /2019**

Subject: List of Eligible TA/RA Scholarship Recipients for the Academic Year, 2019

This refers to the announcement of the graduate school No.2/2019, January 18, 2019 to grant scholarships for Teaching Assistants (TA's) and Research Assistants (RA's) for the Academic Year, 2019.

These scholarships are for graduate students who are enrolled in a regular graduate program and who are doing either master's thesis or dissertation. The scholarships aim to encourage students with high potential to study at the graduate level.

The graduate school is pleased to announce that 70 students out of the 90 applicants have been approved by the committee on March 20, 2019 as follows:

19 Doctoral Students and 51 Master Students:

The maximum amount of each scholarship is 108,000 THB per year, which will be paid by monthly installments, maximum of 9,000 THB per month. The duration of the scholarship is 12 months from August 2019 to July 2020. The scholarship grantee must work as proposed or as recommended by the advisor/program committee/the faculty in charge.

The scholarship grantee must comply with the following conditions:

1. The scholarship grantee must coordinate with his/her advisor/program committee or the faculty in charge in order to have the Terms of Reference/ Job Description for TA/RA. It must be submitted on the day of the scholarship acceptance.
2. The scholarship grantee must confirm the acceptance of the scholarship within May 1st, 2019 at the Student Quality Development Section on the 2nd floor, Graduate School.

For foreign students who are being outside Thailand. Please confirm for the scholarship acceptance via e-mail: jareerat.y@cmu.ac.th.

Otherwise, a waive of the scholarship will be regarded.

Documents required for the scholarship acceptance confirmation:

- (1) Terms of Reference/Job Description for TA/RA.
 - (2) A copy of Citizenship ID card.
 - (3) A copy the first page of his/her bank book; SCB bank, branch of Chiang Mai University or Faculty of Medicine.
3. The scholarship grantee must attend the orientation to be held on August 1st, 2019 at 1.30 pm in room 1-101 of the Graduate School. The advisors/ supervisors in charge are also invited (if available).

4. A full-time student status is required by July 31, 2019. Otherwise, a termination to receive the scholarship will be regarded.

The applicants who failed to receive the scholarship in the 1st round will automatically be gathered and considered in the 2nd round without reapplying. The applicants who is eligible to receive the CMU Presidential Scholarship must choose to receive only one type of the scholarships.
