Subject: Academic Activity Scholarship

The Graduate School is proud to support and promote CMU's Graduate Students. It provides scholarships to further their studies, publish their research, and to attend training courses and various other forms of academic activities. The budget for these scholarships comes from the Graduate School Income, interest from the Graduate School Fund as well as other sources. These scholarships fall into three broad categories: 1) Dissertation/Doctoral work; 2) Thesis/Master's Degree work; 3) Independent Study.

These scholarships are awarded as stipulated below.

1. This announcement will be used from this date forward. It supersedes the Announcement of Graduate School, Chiang Mai University, No. 11/2013 16th September 2013 concerning the academic activity scholarship.

2. Eligible Forms of Academic Activities to apply for the scholarship include:

- 2.1 Publication in an Academic Journal:

2.1.1 National Level in TCI Database	1,000.- THB/ Publication
2.1.2 National Level with Impact Factor	1,500.- THB/ Publication
2.1.3 International Level	2,000.- THB/ Publication
2.1.4 International Level in SCOPUS Database (no Impact Factor)	2,500.- THB/ Publication
2.1.5 International Level with Impact Factor	3,000.- THB/ Publication
2.1.6 Presentation to public in the form accepted by the committee in the field of Fine Arts, Visual Arts and Media Arts:	
- Province Level	1,000.- THB/ Publication
- National Level	1,500.- THB/ Publication
- International Level	2,000.- THB/ Publication

- 2.2 Participation and Presentation:

Participation and Presentation in a Conference accepted by the committee in an area relevant to their field of study. The scholarship covers Travel Expenses, Accommodation, Registration Fees and Allowance

2.2.1 Domestic Activity (within Thailand) 5,000.- THB

2.2.2 Foreign Country Activity (outside Thailand) 10,000.- THB

Any student who is receiving another scholarship covering the expenses for publication, participation and/or presentation must identify the given scholarship with details.

- 2.3 Short Course Training in a Foreign Country:

Short Course Training in a Foreign Country (outside Thailand) for a period of 2 weeks to 3 months: the scholarship covers Travel Expenses, Accommodation, Registration Fees and Allowance to a total of not more than 10,000-THB

3. Terms and Conditions :

Each student is eligible to receive only that form of scholarship stipulated in 2, above. The conditions for receiving the scholarships are stipulated in 4, below.

4. Conditions of academic activity scholarship

- 4.1 Terms and conditions of publication in an academic journal; National Level/ International Level and for the field of Fine Arts, Visual Arts and Media Arts

- 1) The research work must be a joint paper of the student and the advisor/chairman of the dissertation; however, the student must be named as the first author. Additional authors are permitted.
- 2) The research must be accepted for publication.
- 3) The student must have student status on the date of acceptance until the date of participation or presentation.
- 4) The student must indicate that the research work was conducted while studying at Chiang Mai University and acknowledge the financial assistance of the Graduate School.
- 5) In the field of Fine Arts, Visual Arts and Media Arts, the student exhibition must be awarded first, second or third prize only.

4.2 For Foreign Country Participation and Presentation

- 1) The student must be in a Doctoral Degree Program.
- 2) The student must be accepted as a presenter. The presentation can be in the form of an oral presentation or poster presentation.
- 3) The student must be the first author, and the research must be a joint paper between student and advisor/chairman. Additional authors are permitted.
- 4) The student must provide the acceptance letter and the abstract from the proceedings of the conference.

4.3 For domestic participation and presentation

- 1) The student must be enrolled in a Graduate program.
- 2) The student must be accepted to present in the form of oral presentation or poster presentation in the field of Fine Arts, Visual Arts and Media Arts.
- 3) The student must be the first author, and the research must be a joint paper between student and advisor/chairman of the dissertation. Additional authors are permitted.
- 4) The student must provide the acceptance letter and the abstract from the proceedings of the conference.

4.4 Terms and conditions of Short Course Training in a Foreign Country

- 1) The period must be between 2 weeks and 3 months.
- 2) The student must provide the acceptance letter.
- 3) The student must be in a thesis or dissertation program.

5. A student who is receiving another scholarship covering the expenses for publication, participation and Short Course Training in a Foreign Country is not eligible to apply for the academic activities scholarship from the graduate school.
6. Students wanting to apply for the academic activities scholarship can receive the application form at the office of activity and educational quality development at the Graduate School, or at www.grad.cmu.ac.th. To get their application approved from the Dean of Graduate School, they must have their supervisor/advisor sign the form.
7. Student who is approved to receive the degree in the program studying prior to the academic activity to be performed ineligibility and abrogation of the scholarship.
8. The Graduate School will consider all applications, and announce the successful candidates. The number of scholarships each year is set by the budget. Students who want to apply for the scholarship must apply by August 20th. The Graduate School reserves the right to make the final decision to grant, not to grant or to abrogate the scholarship.

1 A national level Academic Journal means a refereed Journal that is well known in a particular academic discipline and which is published within a country.

An International Level Academic Journal means a refereed journal that is well known in a particular academic discipline and which is published internationally.
